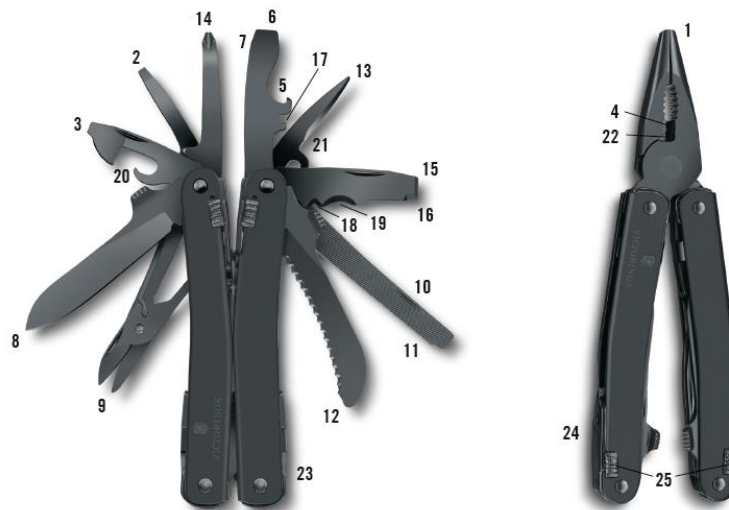
The awarded Multi Tool – Victorinox Swiss Tool Spirit MXBS 3.0226.3AUS (NSN 5110-66-166-1357) was specifically designed for the ADF in order to be fully compliant with the Tender Defence Purchase Description DEF (AUST) 8637 / Issue 5 / Type T.

This new tool features 25 functions including single hand operation of both the primary and secondary blades, designed to successfully integrate with combat gloves. Initial supply to the ADF will commence in 2021 and will support ADF personnel both in Australia and overseas.

Victorinox plans to introduce this new model to the Australian public in 2021.
